



## **Stonemarket Fast Point - Terms and Conditions**

### **Storage**

- Store unopened in cool, dry conditions, away from extreme temperatures
- Shelf life – minimum of 24 months from date of manufacture on unopened
- After opening, unused jointing material can be re-introduced back into its specific container. Clean water must then be added to container. Due to natural evaporation we would recommend filling the container to the top with water. When required, submerged jointing material can then be reused on future projects – this must be within 1 month of submerged containment.

### **Handling**

- Only carry 1 Fast Point tub at any one time as exceeding this advice will exceed the recommended Health and Safety Guidelines for a single person lift – 25kg's
- After extraction from the container, the filled jointing bag will need to be opened utilising a sharp implement. Care must be taken during this process.

### **Installation**

- See installation guidelines for general points
- Stonemarket do not recommend the use of Fast Point around swimming pool paved areas due to the chlorine and chemicals used in their maintenance and upkeep, which in time could affect the performance of the product

### **Disposal**

- Unused jointing material can be reused as per the instructions above.
- The Fast Point container is made of recyclable plastic; therefore, we would recommend recycling the container at your nearest recycling centre once the container is no longer required.

### **Performance**

- We have no influence on the correct implementation of Fast Point jointing material. However, research and development on this product tells us that performance can be guaranteed if Stonemarket's installation guidelines are successfully followed and implemented. This advice is based on the best knowledge we have available and cannot be held liable for anything herein.
- Fast Point is guaranteed for a period of 12 months from date of installation.
